- » 60th Signal Battalion (Offensive Cyber Operations) -- the "Victory" battalion
- » Is the Army's premier cyber threat hunter
- » Operates, maintains and defends strategic cyber infrastructure
- » Is a cohesive team where people who fight and win are the greatest asset
- » Is a brigade of expert innovators who are uniquely trained and leverage superb intelligence and partnerships to drive cyberspace operations and impose cost on our nation's enemies.
